



Re-homing Procedure

If you've come to the decision to re-home your Alaskan Malamute you will no doubt want to ensure that it is found a good, secure and loving home. We can help you! As the only dedicated Alaskan Malamute Rescue and welfare in the UK we have the knowledge and experience to deal with finding your dog a good home.

AMCUK Rescue will only re-home KC registered Alaskan Malamutes.

Please fill in the re-homing form with as much detail and accuracy as possible. Once we have the form our Rescue Liaison will get in touch to organise an assessment on your malamute. It is the responsibility of the owner to ensure our representative's safety is taken care of, so please be open and honest with your descriptions.

We will try to arrange an assessor as quickly as possible but please keep in mind that AMCUK Rescue is run by volunteers who have full time jobs, families and dogs to take care of. It may also be a case we don't have a rep in your area and need to arrange for someone to travel to you. Should you decide to keep your malamute or re-home them privately please let us know so that we can remove them from our list.

Please note, AMCUK Rescue is not a re-homing centre and we do not have our own central dedicated kennels. Therefore we must stress that we are not in the position to simply bring dogs into our care. Your dog will need to remain with you while we find it a new home whether this is a kennel we work with, or a foster home. AMCUK Rescue will however be available for support and help via telephone until your dog has been taken into our care.

In the event AMCUK Rescue are full you will be offered to place your dog on our waiting list until a space becomes available in which will contact you to move forwards with your re-homing application.
